

USB Turntable Instructions

1. Place the album on the turntable. Be sure to select the appropriate speed (33 rpm or 45 rpm). There is an adaptor on the upper left corner of the table for use with 45s.



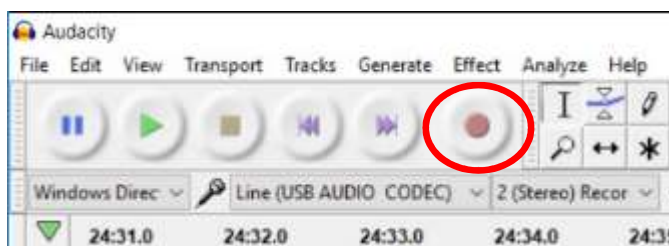
2. Open Audacity.



3. Click Start on the turntable.



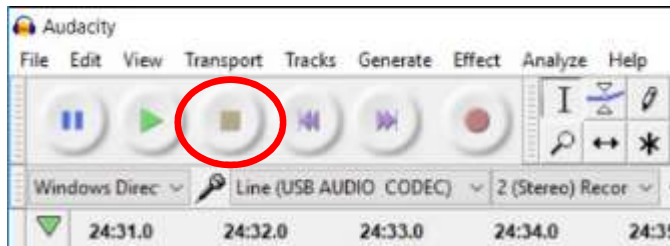
4. Click Record in Audacity.



The album will play through, and Audacity will record the audio. You should notice a blue waveform line on the screen to indicate the audio being recorded.

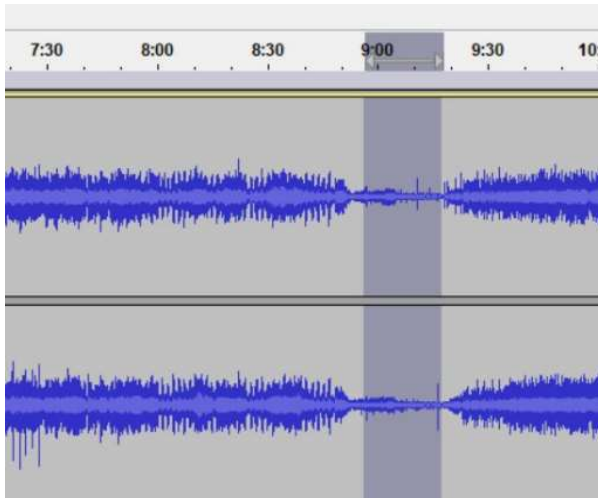
- When the record has played through, click Stop to stop recording.



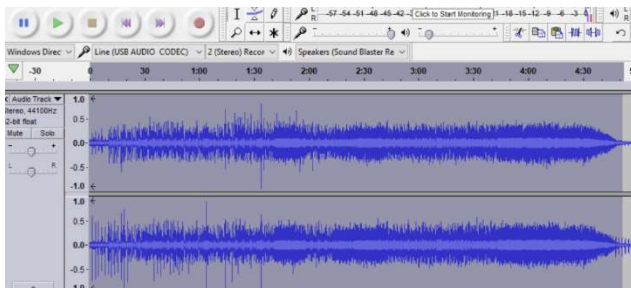
- Click the Zoom Out button until you can see the start and end of a song.



- Select the silences between tracks by clicking and dragging a gray box around the thin portions of the waveform line. Push Delete to remove the selected portions of the recording.

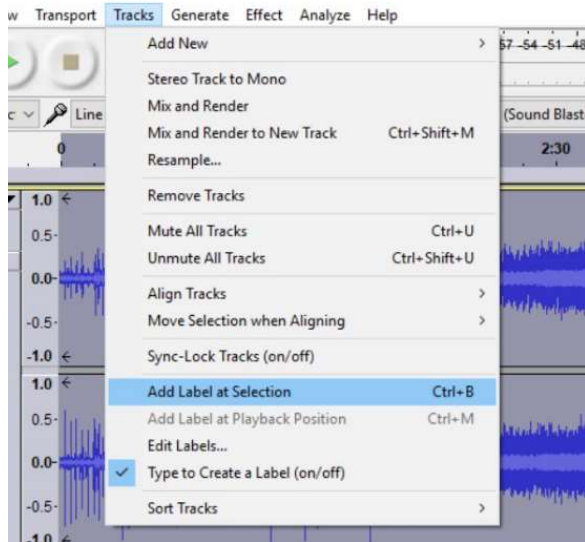


- Click and drag around the waveform line until an entire track is selected in gray.

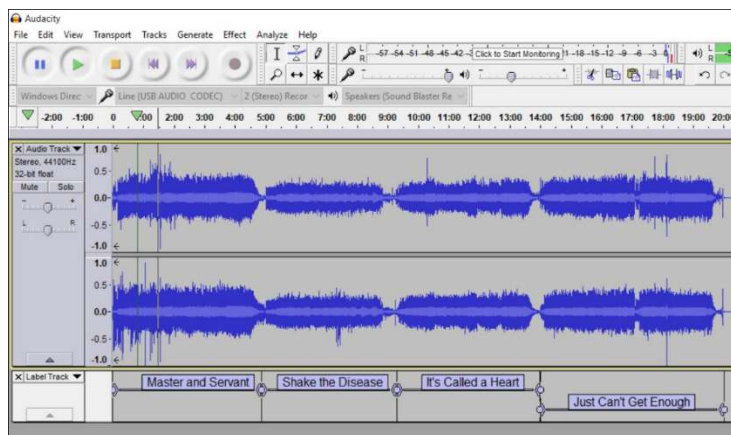

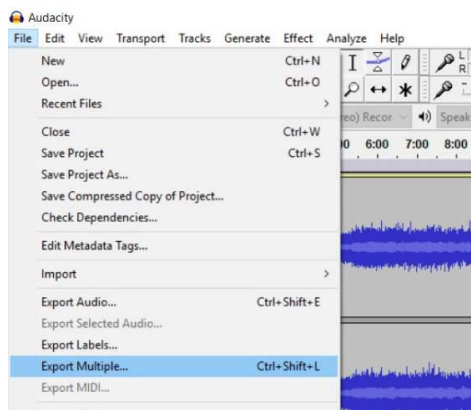
9. Select Tracks, Then Add Label at Selection. Type the name of the track and press Enter.



10. Repeat Step 8 until all tracks are labelled.

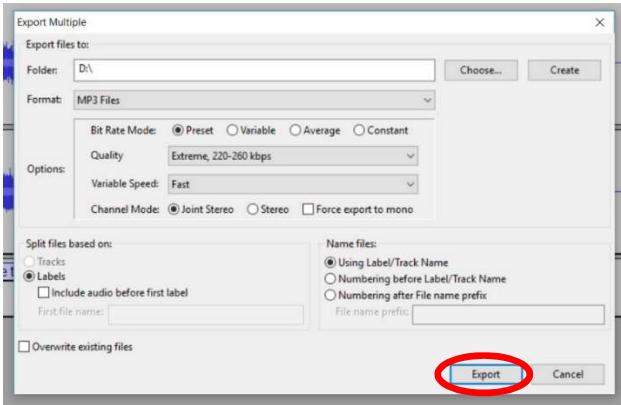


11. Select File, then Export Multiple.

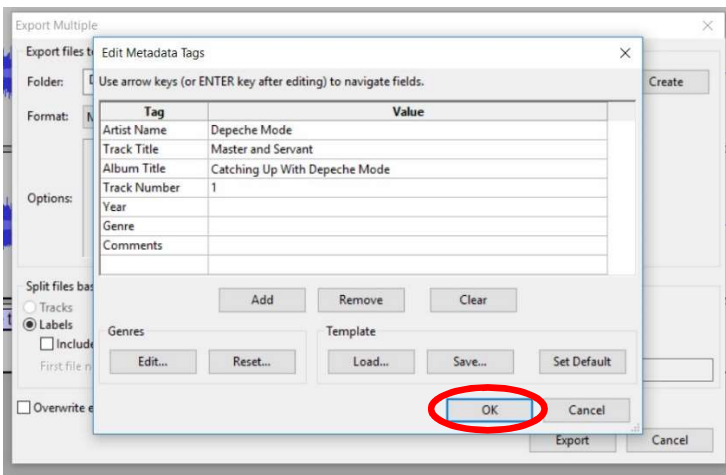

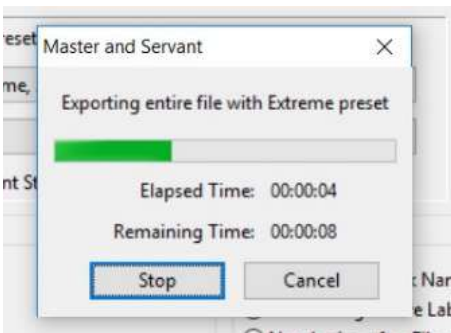
12. Ensure the correct Folder and Export Format are selected. Click the “Name files Using Label/Track Name” radio button. Then click Export.



13. Fill in the Artist Name field, and any other desired Tags. Then Click OK.

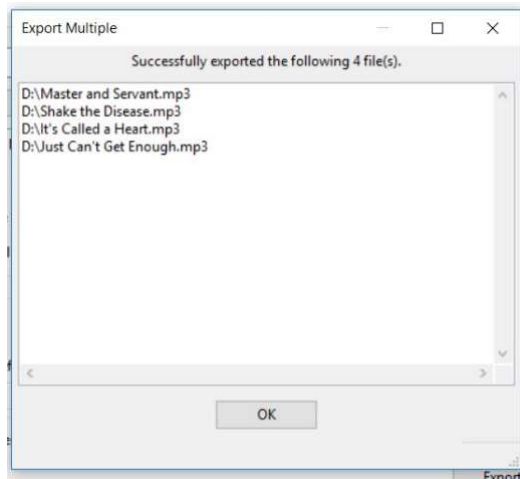


14. A box will appear showing the export progress.

15. A window will appear when exporting is complete. Click OK to close.



16. You're done! You can now close Audacity and remove your USB device.
